Egypt: GDP growth for 2022 according to analysts at the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU) 4.4 %. Population: 104.66 million (2022), forecast 2027: 115.56 million.

Water

- Government plans: approx. 50 billion US\$ investment in the water sector by 2037. Priorities wastewater treatment, expansion of sewerage systems, agricultural irrigation, water desalination plants, construction of small dams to collect rainwater.
- Another US\$ 10 billion (bn) for the Rural Sanitation Services Programme.

Waste

- Waste per year Egypt: 95 to 100 million tons. New waste management act effective since 22 February 2022.
- Goals: Limit waste accumulation and expand recycling.
- Egypt has 28 recycling plants. This number is to be doubled in the next few years. Nine additional waste transfer stations and 20 new landfills are also planned.

Infrastructure

- Average growth of 9 % between 2020 and 2024
- Egypt plans to build up to 14 new smart cities across the country including the Nile Delta.
- Expansion of the new administrative capital east of Cairo with a population of about 6.5 million.
- The government's top priority is to expand the infrastructure between and within the cities and to expand the rail networks, roads and ports for the expansion of industry including the Suez Canal Economic Zone.
